### **A "Cyber" Rotarian?**

A "Cyber Rotarian" is a person who has a desire to serve the community, to "give back" some of their time or good fortune, but who finds they are incredibly time poor, and unable to attend meetings on a regular basis, as is required in a conventional Rotary Club.

This person is comfortable with technology, uses Facebook, twitter, LinkedIn and Skype and being online is a normal occurrence.

"A cyber Rotarian" is also a person with a developed social and business network. A "cyber Rotarian" might also be a past Rotarian who still appreciates the importance and value of Rotary to the community, but is unwilling or unable to attend regular meetings.

### **What is a "Cyber Rotary Club" ?**

In this instance the Cyber Rotary Club will be an operating subsidiary of Strathfield Rotary Club, a physical body of people

who meet in Strathfield Sydney NSW Australia, on a weekly basis, under the rules and privileges of Rotary International.

The members of the Satellite Club would be actual members of Strathfield Rotary Club, however the operating name and Constitution and rules of the Cyber Club are different as membership is not limited to people who live in the Strathfield area.

### **What responsibilities would a cyber Rotarian have ?**

A cyber Rotarian does not have to attend any Rotary meetings (although they are welcome to do so) however they are asked to undertake some reading to understand what Rotary is about.

They will have access to the clubs website and web forums, they will receive the weekly report and update, which will incorporate an active calendar of upcoming events, they may receive videos or podcasts of guest speakers, The Presidents or Director's reports from the physical meeting, and be able to view and communicate via LinkedIn or Facebook, or perhaps Skype, as well as of course email and telephone..

Cyber members may wish to assist in the projects and activities of the parent club (time permitting of course) such as graffiti removal, working on a BBQ, attending school prize giving's, selling tickets to events, or assisting in promoting events such as the "Rotary Stroller Derby".

They may identify candidates for The Pride in workmanship awards. Alternatively Cyber members may identify needs within their own communities, and organise themselves to undertake what may be required.

### **What is the Object of Rotary**

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

- **FIRST:** The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

- SECOND: High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- THIRD: The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;
- FOURTH: The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

### **The badge.**

A Rotarian has the right to wear a Rotary lapel pin. This badge identifies you as an important member of the community, a person who is involved in their community and the wider world, and gives back some of their success to those in the community in need of assistance. It also identifies the wearer as a person having principles, a person who understands the Objects of Rotary and endeavours to live by the principles of The 4 way test. This badge also identifies you to other Rotarians. You have no idea how many doors might open because you wear that badge.

### **The Four way test.**

Is it the truth ?

Is it fair to all concerned?

Will it build goodwill and better friendships ?

Is it beneficial to all concerned ?
