General Ideas:

- 1. Take photos during an event and donate them to the event organizers.
- 2. Plan an Awareness Day for Safe Relationships or Diversity.
- 3. Design a campaign to promote tolerance and understanding of differences.
- 4. Run or walk in a charity race with friends or Rotarians. Eg Lift the Lid Mental Health Walks, Say No to Domestic Violence Walks, End Polio
- 5. Run a lunch time promotion to raise community spirit and create awareness of Social Justice Issues.
- 6. Practise and promote random acts of kindness. You can use cards for this.

On the Calendar:

- 12.Conduct a community service project on days such as Harmony Day or the UN Day of Peace
- 13. Recognize veterans in your community around ANZAC Day
- 14.Organise a awareness campaign and a drive for local Homeless Hubs or shelters during Homeless Week
- 15.Collect items and make hampers for seniors' residential facility, neighbours or homeless shelters. This is an excellent activity at the end of the school year for Christmas.

Children, Family & Friends:

- 16. Surprise your parent(s) or neighbours and offer to babysit a sibling, relative or friend.
- 17. Design a game for young children and involve a local preschool.
- 18.Explore history by interviewing a retired staff member or local nursing home resident about their life.
- 19. Check on either a younger student or an elderly person after school.
- 20. Read a book to a younger child, a visually impaired person or an elderly neighbour.
- 21. Collect Easter Eggs from students and donate them to the Children's Ward in a local hospital.
- 22. Celebrate a birthday by asking friends to donate items for causes instead of gifts.
- 23. Make get well cards for people in hospitals and aged care homes.
- 24. Knit or crochet squares for Wrap with Love

- 25. Write to a children's book author and ask them to donate signed copies, auction the books off and donate the money to local library.
- 26.Collect and donate old glasses to an organization or place that recycles them.

School Activities:

- 27. Paint a mural over graffiti or remove graffiti.
- 28. Hold a used book sale or a swap centre at school
- 29. Organize a "get acquainted" lunch for new students and Interactors at your school.
- 30. Feature community minded people on a school bulletin board.
- 31. Form a study group to help younger students with their schoolwork.
- 32. Volunteer for student council or work together on a project
- 33. Tape you and your classmates reading a story and give it to a children's hospital.
- 34. Conduct a canned goods drive during a school event, display them along a wall within the school and donate the items to a local foodbank.
- 35. Recognize teachers during World Teachers' Day
- 36. Create Posters to raise awareness about import Social Justice Issues. Use your Interact logo and seek permission to put the posters up around the school.

Environmental:
